An assortment of small utensils, old bottles with lids, wilted flowers (deadhead them in place in a bowl), and a few drops of essential oils*

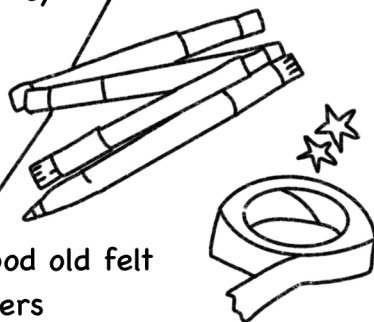


*I find it safer to already add these to cups of water!
